Research continues to show that school staff are often unaware of the extent and frequency of bullying incidents and it's easy for adults to downplay the seriousness of bullying incidents that do occur. Research also shows that rates of bullying drop significantly when all staff members are able to identify the signs and agree to intervene consistently. The following presentations give educators a clear awareness of what cyberbullying is and specific prevention and response strategies to draw on.
