

Through the use of videos and personal stories that students can relate with, they will learn from mistakes others have made, and be encouraged and inspired to do the right thing. They will gain an awareness of the possible outcomes of their online actions, and how it may affect their future.

Includes many of the same areas as 5-6th grade presentation although presented at a more mature level and has additional points.

- Real life examples cyberbullying (presented at a different maturity level)
- Power of words to affect someone's life
- Long term consequences for bullies, victims and bystanders
- Power of bystanders to drastically reduce bullying
- What makes cyberbullying even worse than face to face bullying
- Why it's so easy to be cruel online
- What to do if you're being bullied/cyberbullied

Additional Points:

- How your online behavior affects your real life
- What you post today affects your future-fast forward 20 years
- Anything put online can be copied, reworked and pasted elsewhere

I will encourage and motivate your students to:

- Work together to protect each other
- Understand that actions can have serious consequences
- Learn the importance of their self talk (bullying themselves)
- Think twice about their behavior
- Realize how painful comments add up over time
- Develop empathy and compassion for others
- Open up conversations about bullying
- Think twice about what they write on Facebook
- Make an effort to be kind to one another
